1	Freedom and self-organization in everyday life	1	Productive activities. Freedom, authenticity, and proactivity. The relationship of discipline and freedom. Articulating life's mission and core social roles. Exercise: «Build the plan of your research career».
2	Technology planning	2	Pitfalls and time sinks. Quantification and the laws of time. Features of the scientific career. Exercise: «Planning of the week» (individual presentation and feedback).
3	Software for planning	1	Overview of software for planning and organizing your work. Using the software to create the week plan.
4	Communication in the group	3	Group dynamics. The structure of a small social group. The laws of social communications. Techniques of self-presentation in the group. Ways of organizing work in a small social group. Negotiation and conflict situation in professional activity and communication. Technology of conflict solution in communication. Case studies: 1) «Conflict in a team» 2) «The conversation with a supervisor» 3) Business game for the group interaction.
